



# Disabled Person's Railcard (DPRC) in circulation and issued Publication

## About the data

The Disabled Person Railcard (DPRC) enables disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.

DPRC's are available for both one year and three years in length.

This data is collected by ORR for Disabled People's Protection Policies (DPPP) compliance monitoring.

## Definitions

**DPRC in circulation:** the number of disabled person rail cards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one year and three year railcards.

### DPRC issued (one year) / (three years)

Disabled person railcards issued which either one year or three years in length.

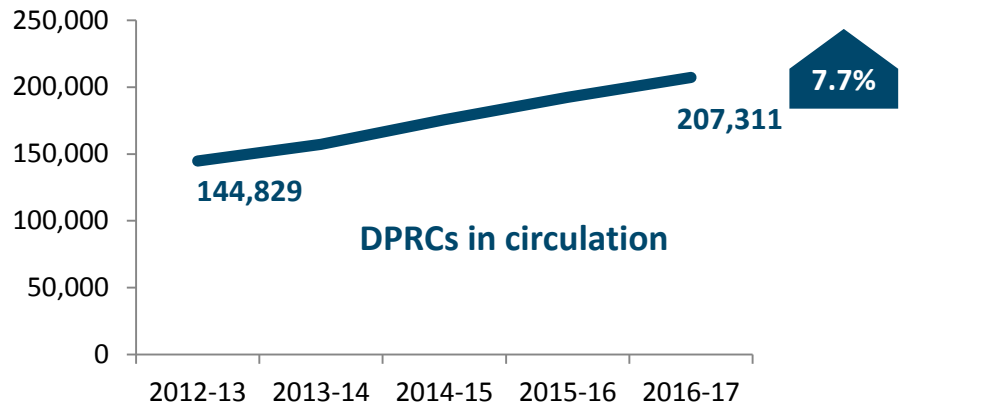

one year railcards issued during 2016-17, a 9.2% increase on last year

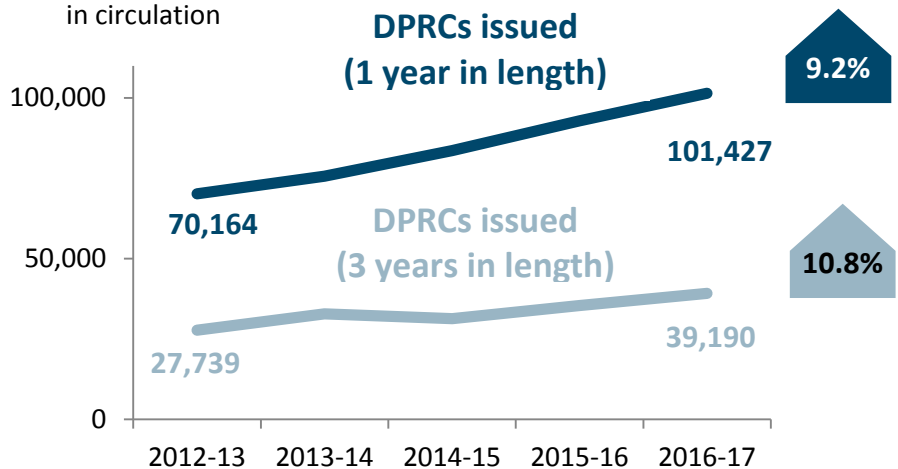
