4.	<p>Introduction to Industry Train Event Data (ITED) platform</p> <p>Elliot presented ITED to the group – he explained the purpose of ITED and provided a technical overview of what it is. He demonstrated how it works and talked about future plans.</p> <p>ITED allows performance problems to be located and corrective actions identified. The purpose of ITED is for the industry to gain greater insight in to the underlying causes of delay (inc. sub-threshold), and hence enable improvements in train performance.</p> <p>ITED is a ‘true to event’ database (e.g., it records data as it happened on the day); it is not a live system. It takes a set of movement (GPS, TRUST, SMART) and contextual data from pre-existing systems and performs automatic linking and a level of processing needed to calculate Dwells and Lateness/Delay at various points.</p> <p>Any Industry performance analyst can have access to ITED (via the NR IT Helpdesk).</p>	13:35 - 14:35	Elliot Hind (NR)
