

# Top 5 most used stations in each region in England, Wales and Scotland in terms of entries and exits.

Between April 2021 and March 2022 Glasgow Central was the most used station in Scotland with 15,322,350 entries and exits. Edinburgh was the second most used station with 13,617,536, Glasgow Queen Street was the third most used station with 8,467,718, Paisley Gilmour Street was the fourth most used station with 2,124,248 and Partick was the fifth most used station with 1,664,560 entries and exits.

Newcastle was the most used station in the North East with 7,040,072 entries and exits. Durham was the second most used station with 2,092,432, Darlington was the third most used station with 2,075,056, Middlesbrough was the fourth most used station with 1,210,906 and Berwick-Upon-Tweed was the fifth most used station with 589,866 entries and exits.

Manchester Piccadilly was the most used station in the North West with 19,581,442 entries and exits. Liverpool Central was the second most used station with 10,747,030, Liverpool Lime Street was the third most used station with 10,464,212, Manchester Victoria was the fourth most used station with 5,820,432 and Moorfields was the fifth most used station with 4,807,882 entries and exits.

Leeds was the most used station in Yorkshire and the Humber with 19,263,472 entries and exits. York was the second most used station with 8,091,546, Sheffield was the third most used station with 7,205,884, Doncaster was the fourth most used station with 3,519,786 and Huddersfield was the fifth most used station with 3,041,816 entries and exits.

Nottingham was the most used station in the East Midlands with 5,202,438 entries and exits. Leicester was the second most used station with 3,548,600, Derby was the third most used station with 2,952,348, Northampton was the fourth most used station with 1,868,756 and Lincoln was the fifth most used station with 1,500,924 entries and exits.

Birmingham New Street was the most used station in the West Midlands with 2,268,2526 entries and exits. Coventry was the second most used station with 4,636,054, Birmingham Moor Street was the third most used station with 4,383,606, Wolverhampton was the fourth most used station with 3,453,320 and Birmingham International was the fifth most used station with 2,411,308 entries and exits.

Cardiff Central was the most used station in Wales with 7,463,378 entries and exits. Newport (South Wales) was the second most used station with 1,753,550, Swansea was the third most

used station with 1,478,016, Cardiff Queen Street was the fourth most used station with 1,366,108 and Bridgend was the fifth most used station with 937,180 entries and exits.

Bristol Temple Meads was the most used station in the South West with 6,627,950 entries and exits. Bath Spa was the second most used station with 4,085,704, Exeter Central was the third most used station with 2,244,104, Exeter St David's was the fourth most used station with 2,206,706 and Swindon (Wilts) was the fifth most used station with 2,048,246 entries and exits.

Brighton was the most used station in the South East with 11,228,212 entries and exits. Reading was the second most used station with 8,818,068, Gatwick Airport was the third most used station with 5,919,044, Oxford was the fourth most used station with 5,013,078 and Southampton Central was the fifth most used station with 4,294,330 entries and exits.

Cambridge was the most used station in the East of England with 6,952,780 entries and exits. Chelmsford was the second most used station with 4,595,710, Watford Junction was the third most used station with 4,127,024, St Albans City was the fourth most used station with 3,876,706 and Peterborough was the fifth most used station with 3,719,850 entries and exits.

London Waterloo was the most used station in London with 41,426,042 entries and exits. London Victoria was the second most used station with 36,776,338, London Bridge was the third most used station with 33,309,348, London Liverpool Street was the fourth most used station with 32,165,310 and Stratford (London) was the fifth most used station with 28,182,238 entries and exits.
