Background:

This factsheet contains information on **Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC)** in **circulation** and **issued** (by one and three years in length) in Great Britain.

DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.

We collect this data as part of our <u>Accessible Travel Policy</u> (ATP) compliance monitoring.



There were 229,733 Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) **in circulation** in rail periods 5 to 7, an increase of 19.2% compared with the same rail periods in the previous year. This reflects the <u>increase in passenger</u> <u>journeys</u> as rail usage recovers from the pandemic.

There were 34,643 one-year and 14,551 three-year DPRC **issued** during rail periods 5 to 7. These were both higher (by 5.9% and 10.1% respectively) than in the same periods three years ago, before the pandemic.

The data table, a quality and methodology report and interactive dashboard associated with this factsheet are published on the Disabled Persons Railcards page of the data portal. Key definitions are at the end of this factsheet.

Overall, **34,643 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 5 to 7 of the latest year. This is 0.4% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year and 5.9% higher than the same rail periods three years ago.

There were **14,551 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 5 to 7 of the latest year. This is 1.6% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year and 10.1% higher than the same rail periods three years ago.

- **DPRC** in circulation: The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and threeyear railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
