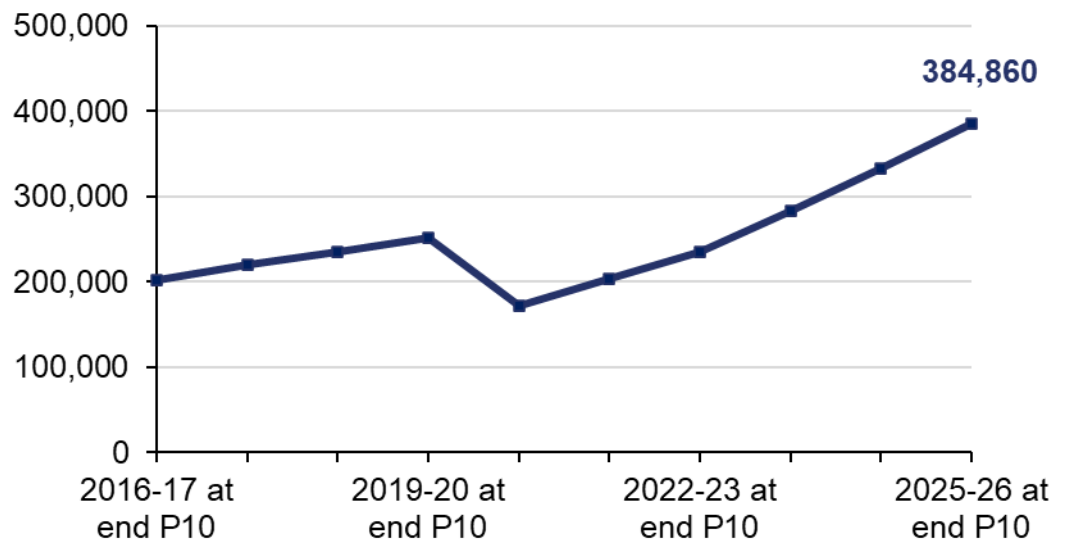

There were **384,860 Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) in circulation** at the end of rail period 10 of the latest financial year (3 January 2026). This is an increase of 15% compared with the end of the same rail period in the previous year. This is the highest number in circulation since the start of the series in 2012.

DPRC in circulation at the end of rail period 10 since April 2016, Great Britain, (Table 4310)



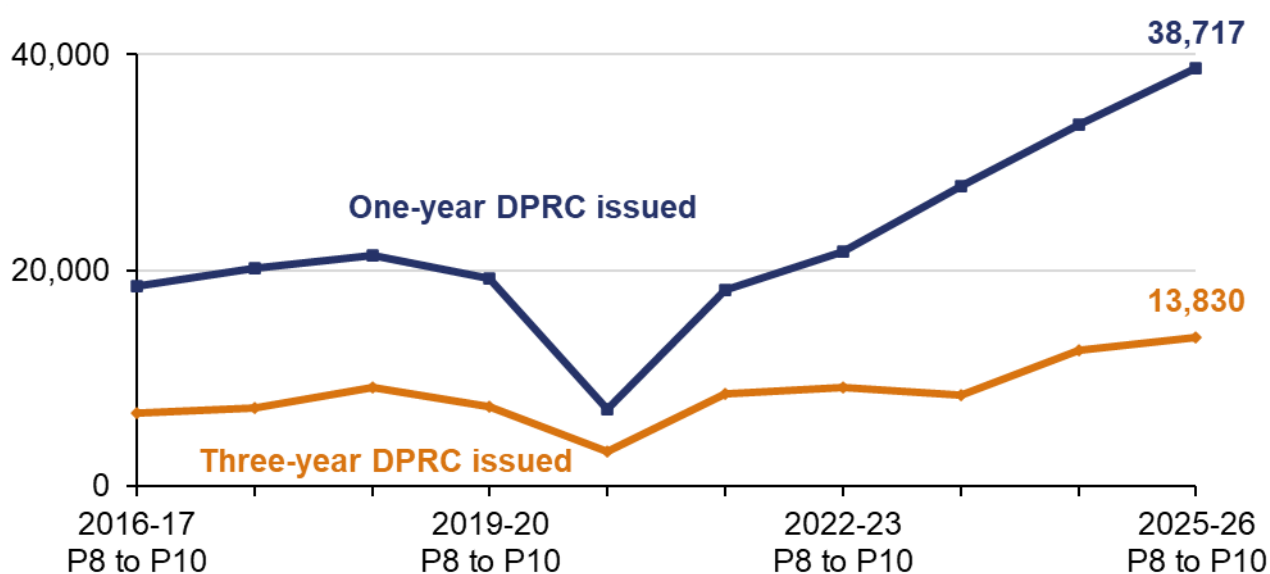

Overall, **38,717 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 8 to 10 (12 October 2025 to 3 January 2026), an increase of 15% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year. This is the highest number issued for these rail periods since the start of the series in 2012.

There were **13,830 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 8 to 10, an increase of 10% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year. This is the highest number issued for these rail periods since the start of the series in 2012.

Definitions

- **DPRC** enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.
- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and three-year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
