This factsheet presents data for the latest full financial year and separately for rail periods 11 to 13.

Background:

This factsheet contains information on **Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC)** in **circulation** and **issued** (by one and three years in length) in Great Britain.

DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult travel on the Network Rail network in Great Britain.

We collect this data as part of our <u>Accessible Travel Policy</u> (ATP) compliance monitoring.




April 2023 to March 2024 annual

There were **296,057 Disabled Persons Railcards** (**DPRC**) in **circulation** at the end of March 2024. This is 22% higher than the number in circulation at same point in the previous year (242,770).



Overall, **148,881 one-year DPRC** were issued in the latest year (1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024), an increase of 20% on the number issued in the previous year.

There were **46,377 three-year DPRC** issued in the latest year (1 April 2023 to 31 March 2024), a decrease of 13% on the number issued in the previous year.


Rail periods 11 to 13 (7 January to 31 March 2024)

Overall, **32,454 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 11 to 13 (7 January 2023 to 31 March 2024), an increase of 22% on the number issued in the same rail periods in the previous year.

There were **9,767 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 11 to 13 (7 January 2023 to 31 March 2024), a decrease of 12% on the number issued in the same rail periods in the previous year.

Definitions

- DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.
- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and three-year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
