

Top 10 most used stations in Great Britain in terms of entries and exits, April 2016 to March 2017 to April 2022 to March 2023

For April 2016 to March 2017 the most used station was London Waterloo, with 99,403,096 entries and exits. The second most used was London Victoria with 75,889,396, third was London Liverpool Street with 67,339,218, fourth was London Bridge with 47,874,250 and London Euston was fifth with 44,059,402.

Birmingham New Street was sixth with 42,366,776, Stratford (London) was seventh with 42,251,592, London Paddington was eighth with 35,835,970 and London Kings Cross was ninth with 33,816,396. London St Pancras International was tenth with 33,492,476 entries and exits.

For April 2017 to March 2018 the most used station was London Waterloo, with 94,354,388 entries and exits. The second most used was London Victoria with 74,954,566, third was London Liverpool Street with 66,965,956, fourth was London Bridge with 48,453,152 and London Euston was fifth with 44,745,552.

Birmingham New Street was sixth with 44,379,256, Stratford (London) was seventh with 40,077,082, London Paddington was eighth with 36,578,130 and London St Pancras International was ninth with 34,621,942. London Kings Cross was tenth with 33,904,522 entries and exits.

For April 2018 to March 2019 the most used station was London Waterloo, with 94,192,690 entries and exits. The second most used was London Victoria with 74,715,808, third was London Liverpool Street with 69,482,532, fourth was London Bridge with 61,308,364 and Birmingham New Street was fifth with 47,925,924.

London Euston was sixth with 46,146,456, Stratford (London) was seventh with 41,206,226, London Paddington was eighth with 38,181,588 and London St Pancras International was ninth with 35,984,204. London Kings Cross was tenth with 34,645,924 entries and exits.

For April 2019 to March 2020 the most used station was London Waterloo, with 86,903,518 entries and exits. The second most used was London Victoria with 73,559,158, third was London Liverpool Street with 65,984,786, fourth was London Bridge with 63,095,300 and Birmingham New Street was fifth with 46,510,526

London Paddington was sixth with 44,871,096, London Euston was seventh with 44,776,804, Stratford (London) was eighth with 41,912,114 and London St Pancras

International was ninth with 36,040,080. London Kings Cross was tenth with 32,532,404 entries and exits.

For April 2020 to March 2021 the most used station was Stratford (London), with 13,985,162 entries and exits. The second most used was London Victoria with 13,791,322, third was London Bridge with 13,763,890, fourth was London Waterloo with 12,214,626 and London Liverpool Street was fifth with 11,212,008.

Highbury and Islington was sixth with 8,660,736, Clapham Junction was seventh with 8,370,706, Birmingham New Street was eighth with 7,350,942 and Barking was ninth with 6,742,918. East Croydon was tenth with 6,695,420 entries and exits.

For April 2021 and March 2022 London Waterloo was the most used station in Great Britain with 41,426,042 entries and exits. London Victoria was second with 36,776,338, London Bridge was third with 33,30,9348, London Liverpool Street was fourth with 32,165,310 and Stratford (London) was fifth with 28,182,238.

London Paddington was the sixth most used station with 23,870,510 entries and exits. London Euston was the seventh with 23,097,606, Birmingham New Street was the eighth with 22,682,526, London Kings Cross was the ninth with 20,476,492, and Manchester Piccadilly was the tenth with 19,581,442.

For April 2022 and March 2023 Between April 2022 to March 2023 London Euston was the tenth most used station in Great Britain with 31.3 million entries and exits.

Farringdon was ninth with 31.5 million and London St Pancras International was eighth with 33.3 million entries and exits.

Tottenham Court Road was seventh with 34.9 million and Stratford (London) was sixth with 44.1 million entries and exits.

London Victoria was fifth with 45.6 million and London Bridge was fourth with 47.7 million entries and exits.

London Waterloo was third with 57.8 million and London Paddington was second with 59.2 million entries and exits.

And London Liverpool Street was the most used station in Great Britain with 80.4 million entries and exits.
