


Disabled Persons Railcards Rail periods 11 to 13 5 January to 31 March 2025


This factsheet presents data for rail periods 11 to 13 (5 January to 31 March 2025) and separately for the latest full financial year.

There were **348,444 Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) in circulation** at the end of March 2025. This is an increase of 18% compared with the end of March in the previous year. This is the highest number in circulation since the start of the series in April 2012 to March 2013.

Background:

This factsheet contains information on **Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC)** in **circulation** and **issued** (by one and three years in length) in Great Britain.

DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.

We collect this data as part of our <u>Accessible Travel Policy</u> (ATP) compliance monitoring.





Overall, **41,102 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 11 to 13 (5 January to 31 March 2025). This is an increase of 27% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year and is the highest number issued since the start of series in April 2012 to March 2013.

There were **17,501 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 11 to 13 (5 January to 31 March 2025), This is an increase of 79% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year and is the highest number issued since the start of series in April 2012 to March 2013.



DPRC issued, Great Britain, rail periods 11 to 13, April 2012 to March 2025 (Table 4310)





Overall, **179,849 one-year DPRC** were issued in the latest year (1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025). This is an increase of 21% on the number issued in the previous year and is the highest number issued since the start of series in April 2012 to March 2013.

There were **69,199 three-year DPRC** issued in the latest year (1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025). This is an increase of 49% on the number issued in the previous year and is the highest number issued since the start of series in April 2012 to March 2013.

Definitions

- **DPRC** enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.
- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and three-year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
