Between April 2022 to March 2023 Glasgow Central was the most used station in Scotland with 20.8 million entries and exits. It was followed by Edinburgh Waverley, Glasgow Queen Street, Paisley Gilmour Street and Edinburgh Haymarket.

Newcastle was the most used station in the North East with 8.4 million entries and exits. It was followed by Durham, Darlington, Middlesbrough and Berwick-Upon-Tweed.

In the North West, Manchester Piccadilly was the most used station with 23.6 million entries and exits. It was followed by Liverpool Central, Liverpool Lime Street, Manchester Victoria and Moorfields.

Leeds was the most used station in Yorkshire and the Humber with 24.0 million entries and exits. It was followed by York, Sheffield, Doncaster and Huddersfield.

In the East Midlands, Nottingham was the most used station with 6.7 million entries and exits. It was followed by Leicester, Derby, Northampton and Lincoln.

Birmingham New Street was the most used station in the West Midlands with 30.7 million entries and exits. It was followed by Coventry, Birmingham Moor Street, Wolverhampton and Birmingham International.

Cardiff Central was the most used station in Wales with 10.2 million entries and exits. It was followed by Newport, Swansea, Cardiff Queen Street and Bridgend.

In the South West, Bristol Temple Meads was the most used station with 9.3 million entries and exits. It was followed by Bath Spa, Exeter St David's, Exeter Central and Swindon.

Gatwick Airport was the most used station in the South East with 16.5 million entries and exits. It was followed by Brighton, Reading, Oxford and Southampton Central.

In the East of England, Cambridge was the most used station with 9.3 million entries and exits. It was followed by Stansted Airport, Chelmsford, St Albans City and Watford Junction.

London Liverpool Street was the most used station in London with 80.4 million entries and exits. It was followed by London Paddington, London Waterloo, London Bridge and London Victoria.
