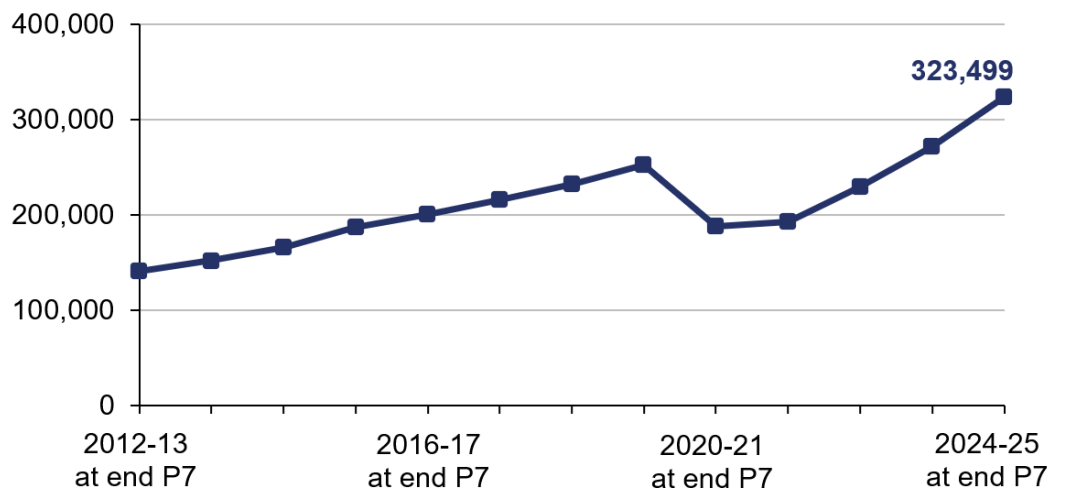

There were **323,499 Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) in circulation** at the end of rail period 7 of the latest financial year (12 October 2024). This is an increase of 19% compared with the end of the same rail period in the previous year.

DPRC in circulation at the end of rail period 7 since April 2012, Great Britain, (Table 4310)

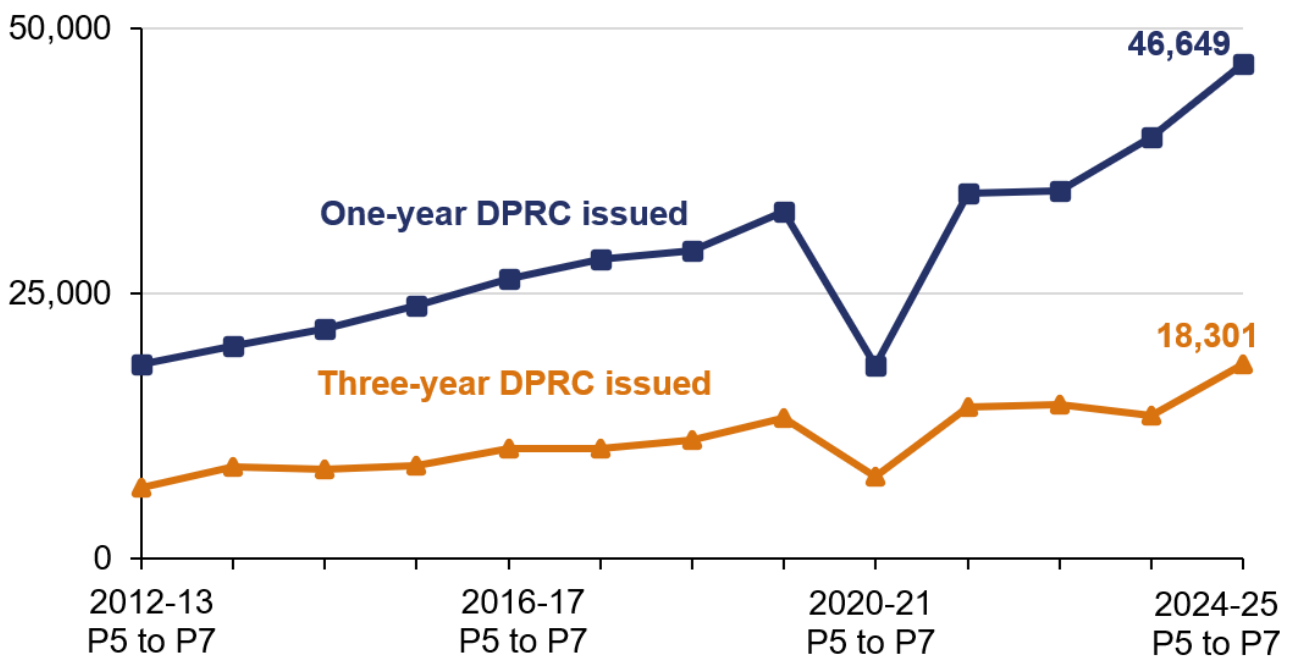


The data table, a quality and methodology report and interactive dashboard associated with this factsheet are published on the [Disabled Persons Railcards](#) page of the ORR data portal. Key definitions are at the end of this factsheet.

Overall, **46,649 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 5 to 7 (21 July 2024 to 12 October 2024), an increase of 17% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year.

There were **18,301 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 5 to 7 (21 July 2024 to 12 October 2024), an increase of 36% on the number issued in the same rail periods the previous year.

Definitions

- **DPRC** enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.
- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and three-year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
